I think the photo of him was probably taken when it say as it was. Not 100% sure though.

I seem to recall you live in Lake Oswego, which is perfect for this case, if you have to do any actual field work. The man whose identity I wish to know lives very close to the Mormon Temple.

What's really tricky about this is the working backwards. I don't know his name. Don't ask me why I was willing to get involved with a man who would not tell me his last name; I can't go back and change that now. I'm just going to provide you with everything that I know that is or seems factual, and if the pieces come together nicely, we might be able to find out who he is. Don't worry; I have no ill intent. This is a matter of my own personal safety, need to know, and my dignity. I doubt I will contact him with anything more than a brief message to establish that I know who he is. If we do discover his identity, that is. There are no guarantees.

One easy way to find out his name would be to ask at one of the establishments that he and I visited in February. But unless you have a clever cover story, I fear that confidentiality may keep the managers from revealing any personal information. And I'm sure both of the businesses are closed at the moment. But just in case, it was February 18th at 8:15 pm that we went to The Elvis Room. It's possible he paid cash, but I'm hoping he used a card. He ordered a glass of wine and a salad for me, and I can't remember what he ate and drank. After that we went to Hawks, across the street - it's a gay bathhouse. I'm sure they'll keep mum. There were three other establishments, in Beaverton and Tigard, but again I have no reason to think that they would reveal the identity of any of their customers. Maybe if I went in there and the lady at the counter recognized me and believed my story, but that's a long shot because it's been quite a while.

Another potentially easy way would be to try his phone number. However, it's highly likely that he gave me a burner number. I can't know either way because I'm sure my number has been blocked. And

his second phone might not even be on anymore, because his wife found out about his dalliances. In any case, this is the number I used to call and text him, whether it still exists or not. [REDACTED]. And the email address he gave me was [REDACTED] I assume he's shut that down as well, on his wife's orders.

So. He told me his name was Kyle. He's in his 50s, which is what made me doubt right away that Kyle could be his name. I challenged him on it, and he chuckled and said it was his real name. I've attached his photo. I met him through a dating app called Hinge. In his description of himself he didn't say much, except that he likes musicals and plays volleyball. He told me that his wife is a schoolteacher and they have one daughter and I think two grandchildren but I'm not sure about the number. His father lives in [REDACTED] and his daughter also lives in Southern California, which is where Kyle is from. I don't know what city unfortunately, or else I'd try to find yearbooks. He might have said San Diego, but then again he might have said a city that's closer to L.A. My guess is that his surname would be a Northern European one - Scandinavian or German or something. He's a member of a Christian church but I don't know which one. He did say he was born-again, and that he was a part of a men's group of some kind. It might have been a men's breakfast. I searched a ton online and found lots of other Portland men named Kyle - fortunately most of them appeared in portraits so I was able to rule them all out. That's another reason why I still doubt that Kyle is his real name. He's intelligent, but I don't think he's quite sharp enough to cover all of his tracks online - it makes no sense that he would have zero web presence. I also found some men's groups in Portland that might be the one he made reference to. One of them is I think for recovering porn addicts, and that's certainly possible for him.

Now here's where we get to some more useful details. I know what neighborhood he lives in, but I haven't spent much time looking around there because I assume he just parks his large Honda SUV (I think it's taupe or beige or gray and after searching I'm guessing it's a Pilot or a Passport) in the garage. It's a pretty tony neighborhood -- I remember remarking the one time I was there that it had to be, because there were no power lines. So that's a useful clue. I don't recall which street he lived on, but looking at Google Street View, I've pretty much narrowed it down to being immediately southeast of the temple, probably between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. It's possible it's a little outside of that area, perhaps in the area that Google maps calls [REDACTED]

The other area in which I gathered some promising information is his work. He told me he works from home, but I don't know if that's true. I searched for many hours to try to determine what company he works for. He has an MBA and he works in marketing - my guess is that he's mid-level, close to executive. The company is somehow involved in computer hardware - I think they manufacture durable touchscreen tablets that can be used in warehouses and the like. It could be Panasonic Toughbook, but they don't seem to have a presence in the Portland area. I actually looked at the websites of dozens of companies that could be in this category, because I had a point of reference: he

was planning to man the company's exhibitor booth at a conference in Atlanta on March 9, 10, 11, but it got cancelled. The only thing that really fits the bill is MODEX - held downtown, which is where he said he'd be. There was another conference that he went to, and that one was in Reno, in late January/early February. I'm trying to find more details on that. I picked him up from the airport but I don't know what the date was. I'm puzzled, because I turned my location to Always for Google maps a few months ago, but it's still not recording my phone's location.
